

Health Screening Checklist

Instructions:

Please check each applicable box regarding symptoms and close contact/potential exposure.

SECTION 1: Current symptoms. Do you have:

- Temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- Sore Throat
- New cough or difficulty breathing (for adults or children with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, this would include a change in cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
- Loss of taste or smell
- None of the above

SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure. Have you:

- Been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 28 days?
- Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least a cumulative of 15 minutes) with a person with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 within the past 2 weeks
- Traveled in the last 14 days to a state that is not exempted by the Maine CDC (if yes, please see below to clarify if/when you can be admitted into a Bet Ha'am building or event)
- None of the above

Travel Policy (as of 11/19/20)

If you have traveled in the past 14 days to a state that is not exempt by the Maine CDC (that is, any place other than NH and VT), a 14-day quarantine, or a 5-day quarantine followed by a negative COVID-19 test after returning to Maine, is required. Please be prepared to produce written documentation of the test result.

Notification Policy:

If you determine, after being in the building or attending a Bet Ha'am event, that you were infected with COVID-19, either presumed or confirmed, at the time of the visit or gathering, please contact Rachel Lefkowitz, in the front office as soon as possible at rachel@bethaam.org or 207-879-0028 x4.
